Grassy River Canoeing Adventures:

Itineraries can be customized and developed based on group size, ages, interests, timing, etc.

Intermediate route C1/C2 - River to Lakes to River- moderate - 3/4 portages daily

Day 1:

Arrive at Wawaitin Holiday Park 1:00PM. Meet your guide, welcome refreshments, orientation and registration, water safety, and light a camp fire to relax your soul.

Day 2:

After a hardy breakfast, head out into the wild. Put-in near Hallladay at the head waters of the Grassy River complex. Move on to Grassy Lake to catch some walleye/pickrel for dinner.

Day 3:

From here, all rivers flow North! You are now paddling your way into Sinclair Lake. After a shore lunch a visit to Nursery Lake before continuing North on the Grassy River.

Day 4:

Local native Heritage is the day's theme while paddling beautiful Kapiskong Lake. Perhaps pick some wild rice and mushrooms and photograph the otters cracking clams on the shore.

Day 5:

Today is for Peterlong Lake, the largest on the Grassy River chain. Northern Pike are abundant so catch a big one (20lbs.+)! There are also opportunities to view and photograph other wildlife such as the curious black bear.

Day 6:

A quick portage around Peterlong dam and you are once again flowing North on the Grassy. Set up camp at high falls and with luck catch some trout for dinner, and dessert - 'bannock' anyone?

Day 7:

This morning, float on to the Mattagami River and paddle to visit a generating station before returning to park around noon. A 'Thanks for Coming' lunch will be served before departing at 1:00PM. WildExodus knows you'll be back!
