### Upper Missinaibi White-water Canoeing Photo Safaris:

*Itineraries can be customized and developed based on group size, ages, budget, interests, timing, etc.*

**Advanced route C1/C3 - whitewater - strenuous - 6/10 portages daily - 40 sets of rapids**

Day 1:

Arrive at Wawaitin Holiday Park on a Friday at 1:00PM. Meet your guide, welcome refreshments, orientation and registration, water safety, and dinner. Light a fire and learn the ways of old voyagers!

Day 2:

This morning we review wilderness survival techniques and after lunch head out to Folyet to learn some Boreal ecology and meet the Saturday 5:00PM train. About two hours later we will set up camp in the Game Preserve.

Day 3:

After exploring the town's ruins we'll paddle down river through Peterbell marsh on to wavy rapids. This is a great area to practice so its our second camp.

Day 4:

After reviewing whitewater maneuvers we move on to scout the challenging Class 3 greenhill rapids. Confidence and water levels considered a decision as to portage or run. Overnight camp at slip rock falls.

Day 5:

Historic Brunswick Lake and a mess of pickerel for our next meal. A restful afternoon in the shade of the cedars. Thunder Falls is our next campsite.

Day 6:

When we rejoin the Missinaibi, more great whitewater paddling. Albany Rapids offer riveting excitement, and our last night on the river is spent on the rugged rocks of Big Beaver Rapids.

Day 7:

Gradually paddling northbound, the trip will end at Mattice near on the C.N.R. tracks. Here we flag down the train to transport us back to civilization.

Day 8:

You will arrive at Wawaitin Holiday Park midday. A 'Thanks for Coming' lunch will be served before departing at 1:00PM. WildExodus invites you to return and canoe the Mattagami water shed with us!
